	5.1 General Update	
	 A reminder was sent further to the letter regarding the invoice for £3,500 (see minutes 12/5/20) however there has been no response to date. Front Door – (authorised at meeting 24/3/20 purchase of Fargo 42 door from Domadeco at £1,500 + VAT, £1,400 grant from Harborough District Council towards this held). Cllr Bladon has not ordered this yet due to Covid-19 restrictions. Now restrictions are easing she will contact the company to see what the position is. The 	
	price may have changed. It was delegated to Cllr Bladon to go ahead with the purchase if the variation does not exceed £50.00. It the variation is more than £50 it will be considered at the next Parish Council meeting	Clir Bladon
	5.2 Update on purchase of floorboard and additional wall cladding and authorisation of clerk's expenses to claim for reimbursement of these items.	
	Purchase of these items was authorised at meeting 24/3/20 from Sheet Materials Wholesale as follows, based on prices on web at 23/3/20 and noting that the prices may vary slightly at time of purchase: • Additional Wall Cladding - £56.40 + VAT • Floor boards - £752.50 + VAT • Delivery £37.50 + VAT • Total £846.40 + VAT	
	The prices today are:

It was agreed to go ahead with the purchase now at £882.60 + VAT in line with the decision on 24/3/20 as restrictions are starting to ease, delegated to Clerk and Cllr Officer to arrange ordering and delivery, clerk to purchase and claim reimbursement

Resolved to approve payment of reimbursement to clerk of £882.60 + VAT = £1,059.12

5.3 To reverse the decision taken on 24/3/20 to purchase floor insulation from Insulation Express as they are not currently trading and to approve purchase from an alternative supplier.

On 24/3/20 it was resolved to purchase floor insulation from Insulation Express for £519.75 + VAT. Purchase was delayed due to the Covid-19 restrictions and now it has been established that the company is not currently trading. The Village Hall Advisory Committee has therefore recommended the decision taken to 24/3/20 be reversed in line with Standing Order 7a.

The Advisory Committee has provided three more quotations (note these were sourced on the web on 21/5/20 and so may be different when ordered)

- Building Supplies Online £584.04 + VAT
- Online Insulation £515.89 + VAT (free delivery)
- Insulation Superstore £546.58 + £50 delivery + VAT

The Village Hall Advisory Committee's recommendation is to purchase from Insulation Online at £515.89 + VAT as it is the cheapest price and includes free delivery.

Note 50% grant funding can be claimed towards this.

It was resolved to reverse the decision to purchase from Insulation Express and instead purchase floor insulation from Online Insulation at £515.89 + VAT. Clerk and Cllr Officer to organise purchase and delivery. As the price may vary it was delegated to the Clerk and Cllr Officer to continue with the purchase if there is a variation as long as the prices remain competitive with the other quotes considered above. Any variation to be minuted at next meeting. Clerk to claim reimbursement.
